

**The 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Cattle Science Conference**  
**Ramada Hotel, Jerusalem**  
**July 10 – July 12, 2012**  
**Call for submission of studies!**

In preparation for the 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Cattle Science Conference, we respectfully invite you to present summaries of studies, trials or field observations in the dairy and beef cattle field, as a lecture or poster and recommend subjects for discussion and lectures. Abstracts of studies will be examined by a scientific referent board; only studies that have been conducted in cooperation with research or instructing entities or institutional bodies of the branch will be examined. Priority will be given to studies with a practical aspect.

**Schedule and submission procedures:** This year, great attention will be paid on meeting the dates indicated below:

1. **By** Wednesday, February 15, 2012, you must send **the name of the study** with identifying personal details (name of presenter and associates in the study and their institutes – all associates must provide approval before submitting the study).
2. **By** Thursday, February 23, 2012, proposals for subjects for **discussion** and lectures are to be sent.
3. **By** Thursday, March 30, 2012, a synopsis of a **study** is to be sent.  
**By** Thursday, April 15, 2012, a synopsis of a **lecture** is to be sent.

**The scientific board of the conference reserves the right to exclude from the conference subjects or studies that are submitted after the specified dates and disqualify works at its professional discretion!**

4. A notice of deferral of studies will be sent to submitters by Monday, April 30, 2012. The board reserves the right to ask the investigator to present his study as a poster.
5. The name of the study (final, binding version) and synopsis are to be sent as a Word file to Dr. Joshua Miron, by email to: [michalav@moag.gov.il](mailto:michalav@moag.gov.il) and to [kenesbakar2012@gmail.com](mailto:kenesbakar2012@gmail.com).

The filename must be **the surname of the principal investigator** in Latin letters (e.g. cohen.doc). If there is more than one abstract, the filename must be appended with its number (cohen1.doc).

**6. Binding directions for writing the abstract follow:**

- A. In the "Subject" window of the email program, indicate the field of the study: nutrition, fertility, etc.
- B. Abstract file – using Microsoft Office Word 2007 (an abstract written on Microsoft Office Word 2010 is to be saved as a Word 2007 file).
- C. Body text of the abstract – Narkisim font size 13, justified.
- D. Title/ name of abstract - Narkisim font size 16, bold, centered.
- E. Names of authors – font size 15 and centered. At the end of the name, indicate a superscripted digit and in the row under the names of the authors the name of the department, institute, in size 14 and right aligned (for Hebrew). Mark an asterisk (\*) next to the name of the study presenter.
- F. Line spacing: 1.5 lines; A4 page format; margins: 2.5 cm top, bottom, left and right.
- G. **Abstract – up to two pages – including tables and figures (in Hebrew only: figures in black and white only).** It is preferable to add a table of data / main results + statistics to the abstract. Note at the end of the abstract the name of the body and the funding of the study.

**The order and date of presentation of lectures in the conference will be determined based on the considerations of the scientific committee.**
